

BY-LAW NUMBER 144
A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MINTO RESPECTING DANGEROUS OR
UNSIGHTLY PREMISES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF MINTO

Be it enacted by the Common Council of The Village of Minto as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as the Minto Unsightly Premises and Dangerous Buildings By-Law.
2. The Common Council hereby declares that Sections 190.001 to 190.07 of the Municipalities Act, begin Chapter M-22 of the Revised Statutes of New Brunswick 1973 and amendments thereto, shall apply to the entire area within the municipal limits of Minto.
3. This By-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.
4. By-Law No. 64B, “a By-law of the Municipality of Village of Minto Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises: enacted on the 13th day of August 2002 is hereby repealed.
