

BY-LAW NO. 1

BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF MINTO

The said Village of Minto shall comprise that part of the County of Sunbury and that part of the County of Queens, in the Province of New Brunswick within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at a point one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) mile North of the intersection of the North Minto Stream Road where it connects with Highway #10, leading from Minto to Chipman; thence a mile due East from Highway #10; thence in a southerly direction parallel to Highway #10 until it crosses the highway leading from Minto to Newcastle Creek to a point 500 feet beyond said Highway; thence proceeding in a due Westerly direction to the boundary of the Kelley Road; thence along the Kelley Road to the intersection of the Kelley Road and the Road leading from Rothwell to the Avon and 500 feet beyond said Avon Road in a Southerly direction; thence following the Avon Road to the Evans Road; thence along the Evans Road to the first Transmission Line of the N. B. Electric Power Commission; thence following the said Transmission Line to Highway #10; thence in a direct line in a North Westerly direction to the intersection of the New Avon Road and the Bannister Road and continuing up the Bannister Road 500 feet; thence following parallel to the New Avon Road in a North Easterly direction across the Canadian Pacific Railway tracks to the Miramichi Lumber Company's hauling road; thence along Miramichi Road to the intersection of the road leading from Minto to New England; thence in a direct line to the Slope Road at a point one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) mile from the boundary of the said road and continuing to the place of beginning.

Subject to amendment on approval of the Council according to the Municipalities Act.
