

BYLAW NUMBER 110
WINTER PARKING BYLAW

INTERPRETATION

1. In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires,

(a) words which are defined in Section 1 of the Motor Vehicle Act of New Brunswick and Amendments thereto have the meaning as so defined for the purposes of this bylaw.

RESTRICTED PARKING

2. In the months of December, January, February and March, between the hours of midnight and seven o'clock in the forenoon of any day, no person shall park a vehicle unattended on any street or highway within the Minto Village limits.

IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES

3. Any peace officer may remove and impound any vehicle which is found illegally parked on any street or highway within the Minto Village limits and no person shall take possession of a vehicle so removed or impounded until all costs and charges for, removal, care and storage of such vehicles have been paid.

PENALTIES

4. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$200.00.

BYLAW REPEALED

5. BY-LAW NO. 23 AND BY-LAW NO. 23A ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

BY-LAW NUMBER 110 A

A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE WINTER PARKING BY-LAW

The Council of the Municipality of Minto under the authority vested in it under the Municipalities Act enacts as follows:

Section 2 of By-law Number 110 is hereby amended to correct an error on line 3 of this section by replacing the word "part" with the word "park".

Section 4 of By-law Number 110 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following new Section 4.:

4. A person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is punishable under Part 11 of the Provincial Offences Procedures Act as a category B offence.

BY-LAW NUMBER 110B

A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE WINTER PARKING BY-LAW

The Council of the Municipality of Minto under the authority vested in it under the Municipalities Act enacts as follows:

Section 4 of By-law Number 110 & 110A is hereby repealed and replaced with the following new Section 4:

4 . Penalties:

- (1) Every person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence.

- (2) Every person charged with an offence under any section of the By-law may on or before the date the filing of the Information, a person may pay a voluntary payment of \$25.00 for a first offence,
- (3) If the voluntary payment set out in section 4(2) has not been received on or before the date of the filing of Information, the person charged with the offence may make a voluntary payment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a second offence as full satisfaction for such violation of this By-law provided that no “removal” or impound” costs have been incurred, in which case the payment of such costs must also be paid prior to any release or discharge of the violation
- (4) The voluntary payment set out in either section 4(2) or 4(3) shall be made payable to the Village of Minto as follows:
- in person at 420 Pleasant Drive, Minto, in cash or by certified cheque or money order made payable to The Village of Minto;
- Or
- by mail to: The Village of Minto, 420 Pleasant Drive, Minto, N.B., E4B 2T3, “Attention Clerk Administrator”, by certified cheque or money order only, payable to The Village of Minto;
- at which time the ticket or ticket number shall be surrendered to the Village of Minto and such payment shall be deemed payment in full.
- (5) If the voluntary payment set out in either section 4(2) or 4(3) has not been received on or before the filing of the information before the Provincial Court, the person charged with the offence is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than eighty dollars (\$80.00) and not more than the maximum fine (\$125.00).
