

BY-LAW NUMBER 129  
A BY-LAW RELATING TO PARKING IN THE VILLAGE OF MINTO

The Council of the Municipality of Minto hereby enacts as follows:

1. APPLICATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE ACT

This by-law is complimentary to and must be construed in conjunction with the New Brunswick Motor Vehicle Act, Chapter M-17, R.S.N.B., 1973 and amendments thereto, and any act subsequently enacted by the Legislation of the Province of New Brunswick in replacement thereof.

DESIGNATED NO PARKING AREAS

2. (a) No person shall park a vehicle in an area designated "No Parking" by posted signs.

(b) No person shall park a vehicle on the Southerly side of Theatre Street from Main Street to Hill Street.

(c) No person shall park a vehicle on the Northwest side of Patterson Street from Pleasant Drive, along Patterson Street, to the property currently owned by Walter Northrup, civic address being 28 Patterson Street in the Village of Minto, a distance of approximately 2/10 (two tenths) of a kilometre.

(d) No person shall park a vehicle on that side of a street displaying a "Snow Removal - No parking" sign for the duration of its posting.

VIOLATIONS

(e) Any R.C.M.P. officer or By-law Enforcement Officer of the Village of Minto may order the removal and impounding of any vehicle which is found illegally parked on such streets and no person shall take possession of a vehicle which has been impounded until all costs and charges for removal, care and storage of such vehicle has been paid.

(f) There shall be no liability attached to any official designated by the R.C.M.P. or the Village of Minto for any damages to a motor vehicle removed from a street as a result of a violation of this by-law.

PENALTIES

3. (a) Any person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00.

4. Where a person is alleged to have committed a violation of this by-law and prior to the filing of the Information part of a traffic ticket, a person may pay a voluntary penalty of \$25.00 for a first offence, \$50.00 for a second offence or \$100.00 for a third offence as full satisfaction for such violation of this By-law provided that no "removal" or "impound" costs have been incurred, in which case the payment of such costs must also be paid prior to any release or discharge of the violation. Voluntary payment may be made to the Village of Minto as follows:

(i) in person at the Minto Village Office, 420 Pleasant Drive, Minto, N. B. in cash or by cheque or money order made payable to the Village of Minto, or

(ii) by mail to: Village of Minto, P. O. Box 7,

at which time the ticket or ticket number shall be surrendered to the Village of Minto and such payment shall be deemed to be payment in full.

5. By-law Number 128 is hereby repealed.

BY-LAW NUMBER 129B

A BY-LAW TO AMEND A BY-LAW RELATING TO PARKING  
IN THE VILLAGE OF MINTO

The Council of the Municipality of Minto under the authority vested in it under the Municipalities Act enacts as follows:

Section 3 of By-law Number 129 & 129A is hereby repealed.

Section 4 of By-law Number 129 & 129A is hereby repealed and replaced with the following new Section 4. :

**4 . Penalties:**

- (1) Every person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence.
- (2) Every person charged with an offence under any section of the By-law may on or before the date of the filing of the Information part of a traffic ticket, a person may pay a voluntary payment of \$25.00 for a first offence,
- (3) If the voluntary payment set out in section 4(2) has not been received on or before the date of the filing of Information, the person charged with the offence may make a voluntary payment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a second offence as full satisfaction for such violation of this By-law provided that no “removal” or impound” costs have been incurred, in which case the payment of such costs must also be paid prior to any release or discharge of the violation
- (4) The voluntary payment set out in either section 4(2) or 4(3) shall be made payable to the Village of Minto as follows:  
  
in person at 420 Pleasant Drive, Minto, in cash or by certified cheque or money order made payable to The Village of Minto;  
  
Or  
  
by mail to: The Village of Minto, 420 Pleasant Drive, Minto, N.B., E4B 2T3, “Attention Clerk Administrator”, by certified cheque or money order only, payable to The Village of Minto;  
  
at which time the ticket or ticket number shall be surrendered to the Village of Minto and such payment shall be deemed payment in full.
- (5) If the voluntary payment set out in either section 4(2) or 4(3) has not been received on or before the filing of the information before the Provincial Court, the person charged with the offence is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than eighty dollars (\$80.00) and not more than the maximum fine (\$125.00).
